COVID-19 Vaccines, Boosters Now Available at Missoula Public Health

Missoula Public Health (MPH) is now offering COVID-19 vaccines and booster shots. These vaccines will be available at the MPH offsite clinics listed below, as well as at MPH's walk-in Immunization Clinic at 301 W. Alder St. Hours for the walk-in clinic are 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday. On Wednesdays, vaccines at the clinic are available by appointment only. Schedule an appointment by calling 406-258-3363.

People should bring a photo ID, their insurance card and their COVID vaccination card if they have it. For those without insurance, there is a sliding fee scale for kids ages 18 and younger who qualify for VFC and for adults who qualify for the Bridge program.
